Introduction

- Council agreed to draft business plan and report back to Council in early 2024.
- First version was presented to the 3G working group in December 2023
- ► This is revised draft Business Plan for comment
- It has a number of queries and challenges
- ▶ The business plan is a key element of the submission to the Football Foundation
- If the Business Plan is not sustainable, it will not be accepted by Football Foundation
- The Cllr site visits to local 3G pitches illustrated high usage and covering their costs

Challenges

- Very early in process
- Football clubs keen as they realise importance of been pencilled in for a slot
- Community groups wait and see
- Staplehurst Primary School once per year event
- Cranbrook Rugby keen want Saturday am for Tag Rugby
- Charlton Athletic Community Trust supportive
- Youth service ad hoc use
- Symbol Trust / Sobell Centre wait and see
- Active Sports (Disability) meeting arranged
- Day time usage will be challenging schools do not like travelling
- Potential for an Academy programme
- Currently seeking contractor to manage of site

Draft Business plan principles and assumptions

Principles

- Use Football Foundation template part of submission to Football Foundation, if the business plan is not sustainable then it will not be accepted by Football Foundation.
- Baseline year before opening in effect council working budget 2024/25?
- Year 1 September 2025 August 2026
- Year 2 September 2026 August 2027 and so on
- 5 year Business plan
- 3% standard inflation
- Football Foundation Target groups are: Women & Girls, Disabilities, Diverse Ethnic Communities and Low Socio-Economic Groups - can offer reduced fees to target groups

Assumptions

- Lighting permission to 10pm weekdays,
- No marketing so focus on known groups at moment.
- The Council is starting a tender process for a Contractor to manage the Jubilee Field
- Contractor will report directly to Council and form a "user group" based on the JFWG.

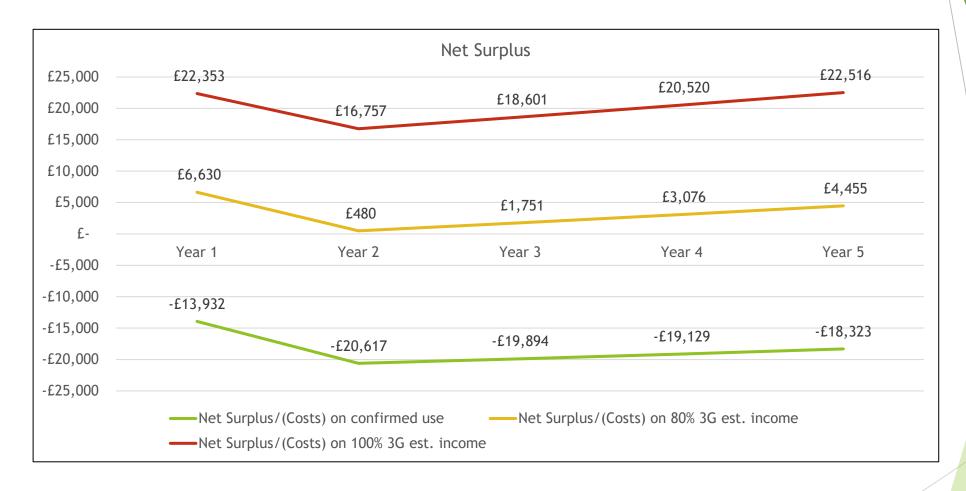

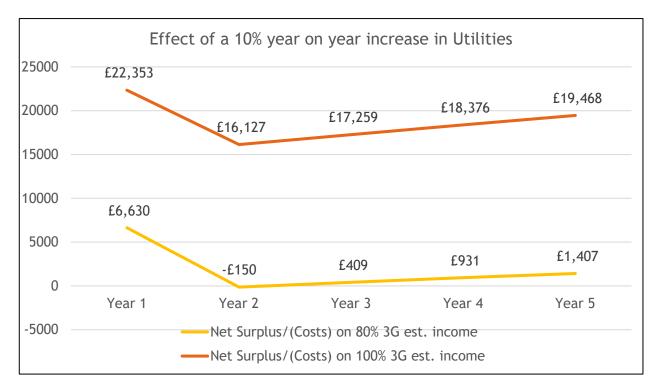

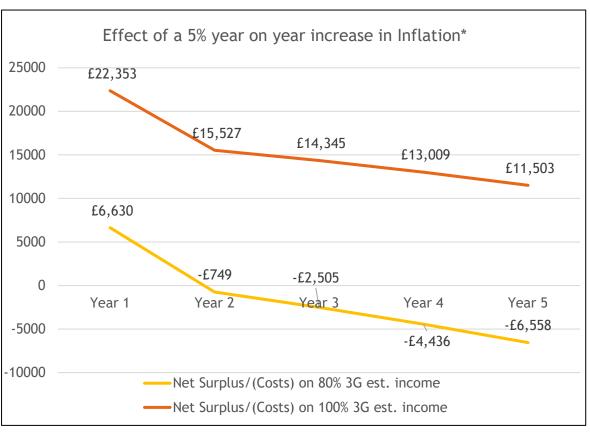
5 Year Income & Expenditure forecast
