

Suggested 20mph speed limit area in Staplehurst

Dear Residents,

The safety of pedestrians of all ages is of great concern to Staplehurst Parish Council and residents. One possibility is to apply to the Maidstone Borough Council Joint Transportation Board and Kent County Council Highways Department to be part of their 'pilot studies' into 20mph speed reduction areas.

One suggestion is shown by the hatched area to slow traffic near the school, recreation ground and Pope Drive grass area. No scheme is without costs and it is paramount that the Parish Council can clearly demonstrate that a scheme would have wide public support.
