1.Drainage quote

The drain repair work is urgent as the situation will only get worse with time. Dynarod initially advised that this work would cost c £1000. We have quote from a trusted supplier for less than that amount. It will be difficult to obtain other quotes for this work.

ACTION Recommend to Council that we accept and proceed with the quote provided and do not spend more time in a likely fruitless search for another supplier.

2. Ramp Quotes

We now have three quotes for the same specification of work. (no brick wall included). This work is now long delayed. The supplier for the least expensive quote has indicated that they could not start work until mid-summer. The 2nd lowest quote was for £3930 (no VAT req.) but this supplier could be contracted to begin work on 17th April. This supplier has previously carried out satisfactory work at Wimpey Fields.

ACTION Recommend to Council to proceed with this quote (HARTLAKE GARDEN SERVICES)

Shed Security

Was discussed. Nothing is missing from the shed (KCC have borrowed the goals). The shed is only made of plywood so security will be a long term issue.

ACTION SMCP to ask Men's' Shed to resecure the padlock fitting.

ACTION Paddy to request and organise signage clarifying sheds hold nothing of value.

Electricity Meter

It was noted that we will probably receive a bill now that we have provided a meter reading. Meanwhile, Deputy Clerk is obtaining quotes with a view to switching to a less expensive electricity supplier.
