# MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF STAPLEHURST PARISH COUNCIL held at Staplehurst Village Centre on Monday 7<sup>th</sup> July 2014 at 7.40 p.m.

**URGENT ITEMS**: - Councillors took one item of urgent business relating to the Chairman's position.

#### **COUNCILLOR DECLARATIONS:**

<u>Lobbying</u> – Councillors Buller, Burnham, Lain-Rose, Perry, Silkin and Spearink declared they had been lobbied about street lights. Councillors Buller and Lain-Rose declared they had been lobbied about the Neighbourhood Plan. Councillors Lain-Rose, Perry and Spearink declared they had been lobbied about Lime Trees parking. Councillor Perry declared he had been lobbied about street cleaning. Councillor Lain-Rose declared he had been lobbied about the Youth Club.

<u>Changes to the Register of Interests</u> – none declared.

<u>Interests in items on the agenda</u> – Councillor Kelly declared an interest in Lime Trees parking.

### **CORRESPONDENCE & CURRENT ISSUES for noting or decision:**

- 1. <u>Urgent Items</u> Chairman Perry advised that due to his MBC responsibilities, including as a Cabinet member, he felt it would be prudent to stand down from the position of chairman and from planning committee membership after the end of August.
- 2. <u>Neighbourhood Plan</u> Review of Reg. 14 Consultation to date. The Clerk asked councillors to support the drop-in event at the library on 12<sup>th</sup> July. He said at the half-way point in the consultation process 14 on-line questionnaires had been completed and that he awaited updated figures.
- 3. <u>Caretaker's Report</u> no items to report.
- 4. <u>Honours List 2015</u> NALC correspondence about how to make nominations was noted by councillors.
- 5. <u>Jubilee Field</u> Repair of equipment (for decision). Councillors asked for further information about the cause of the damage to the CCTV camera and for a temporary replacement to be expedited before committing to expenditure.
- 6. <u>KALC Clerks' Conference</u> Councillors noted the Clerk's report (posted at <a href="http://www.staplehurstvillage.org.uk/kent\_association\_of\_local\_councils.aspx">http://www.staplehurstvillage.org.uk/kent\_association\_of\_local\_councils.aspx</a>).
- 7. <u>Kent County Councillor Meeting</u> Verbal Report. Chairman Perry reported that subjects discussed with Cllr Hotson included highways issues, KCC library service and ownership of Surrenden Playing Field.
- 8. <u>Kent Highways</u> Councillors noted the report of the meeting with Kent Highways representatives that covered planned works, the Neighbourhood Plan, planning issues

- and vegetation enquiries. Councillor Green said that although grass verges along Maidstone Road had been trimmed hedges also needed attention.
- 9. Street Lights Request to halt decommissioning in Chapel Lane (for decision). Chairman Perry closed the meeting to allow contributions from members of the public. Several residents spoke about the importance of the two lights to users of Chapel Lane and lack of consultation by the Parish Council when it decided to decommission them. Chairman Perry reopened the meeting. Some members of the council expressed views about the lights and regrets for failings in consultation. Proposed by Councillor Burnham, seconded by Chairman Perry, councillors agreed to place a halt on decommissioning the two lights in Chapel Lane while other options could be investigated, specifically subsidising private provision of light, for example by the chapel should it wish to do so, or replacing the two lights with a new single public one, such investigation to involve local residents. Chairman Perry closed the meeting to allow further contributions from members of the public. A resident spoke about the importance of both lights. Chairman Perry reopened the meeting.
- 10. <u>Library Surgery</u> Report (JP & SL-R). Chairman Perry said two visitors had discussed solar farms.
- 11. <u>Maidstone Borough Council Update</u> Chairman Perry said that the new MBC Cabinet wanted to review past events and was determined to adopt a fresh approach, including making the Neighbourhood Plan experience better.
- 12. <u>Parish Council Elections 2015</u> Proposal for Action. Councillor Green proposed a course of action ahead of the 2015 elections to encourage interest in serving as a member of the Parish Council. Councillors agreed that it was important to start this process now and to prepare the ground for publication of candidate details (both existing and potential new councillors) on the village website and posters next year. Councillors also agreed that an information evening would be a good idea.
- 13. <u>Parking on Lime Trees</u> Proposal to support extended restrictions. Councillor Spearink said he had been in contact with the Head of MBC Parking Operations who had explained the department's approach following introduction of new measures. Councillors agreed that it would be appropriate to allow the new measures time to take effect and thereby assess the true impact.
- 14. <u>Rural Housing Policy Review</u> Questionnaire (for decision re response). Councillors agreed to Chairman Perry's proposal that he liaise with Councillors Burnham and Kelly and the Clerk to respond to the questionnaire received via KALC about the Council's views on rural affordable housing.
- 15. <u>Street Cleaning</u> Proposal to extend parish cleaning. Chairman Perry said he had received a number of comments about rubbish on rural roads. Councillor Kelly discussed the practical difficulties of cleaning verges and ditches. Councillor Green asked that other parishes be approached to ascertain what, if anything, they did.
- 16. <u>Surrenden Playing Field</u> Extension of Lease (JP) & Drainage (TB). Councillors agreed to defer discussion about drainage work pending an updated view on the freehold or leasehold of the field that Chairman Perry would seek from MBC representatives.
