Area cleared and dead hedge screen in place.

Plants for Bees/Butterflies – David Charge provided a list of plants for bees. Butterfly list was being worked on.

Honeysuckle by the children's area by the dead hedge.

Two ready to be transplanted.

School classroom, meeting at Friday 12.30pm by the Map on the Wimpey Field.

Meeting held. Construction to start as soon as wood can be collected. Further information on Forest schools to be sought.

Woodland Trust – gives free trees to organisations. PR to take this up with the Jubilee Fields and Wimpey Fields to choose a selection, as they don't need the entire selection.

Water issue – it is important to have water for plants and animals, particularly for Summer 2018.

Discussion regarding discussion with Southeast Water and the local Fire department.

Clerk has written to Southern Water about the possibility of getting a standpipe on the grasscrete area.

Bins – Pets World may donate the bins. Parish Council to empty, utilising the Caretaker – to raise with the Employment Group.
